RESOLUTION 22-11

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF YEMASSEE, SOUTH CAROLINA, TOWN COUNCIL TRANSFERRING THE FIVE MEMBERS OF THE TOWN OF YEMASSEE ZONING BOARD TO THE TOWN OF YEMASSEE PLANNING COMMISSION AND APPOINTING SAID MEMBERS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OUTLINED WITHIN THE SOUTH CAROLINA CODE OF LAWS, COMPREHENSIVE PLANNING ENABLING ACT OF 1994

WHEREAS, the Town of Yemassee appointed five members to the Zoning Board of Appeals on April 12, 2022, by virtue of Resolution 22-06; and

WHEREAS, the appointed members were selected from a committee application pool with one representative being selected from each "zone" and an at-large member to initiate the Zoning Board; and

WHEREAS, the Comprehensive Planning Enabling Act of 1994 requires a Planning Commission be appointed and active prior to commencing an update on the town comprehensive plan, which is required by law; and

WHEREAS, the Town desires to initiate the Comprehensive Plan process and in order to do so, a Planning Commission must be re-established, and members appointed; and

WHEREAS, the Town will transfer the five members from the Zoning Board of Appeals and appoint them to the Planning Commission to help initiate the comprehensive planning process: and

WHEREAS, the Town will actively seek individuals to serve on the Town Zoning Board of Appeals and the Town encourages individuals to take part in Town Council appointed Boards & Committees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Yemassee, SC, that the five members of the Zoning Board of Appeals are hereby appointed to the Planning Commission, vacating their seats on the Zoning Board of Appeals, and the Town will actively encourage interested individuals to apply for the Zoning Board of Appeals and other Town committees.
