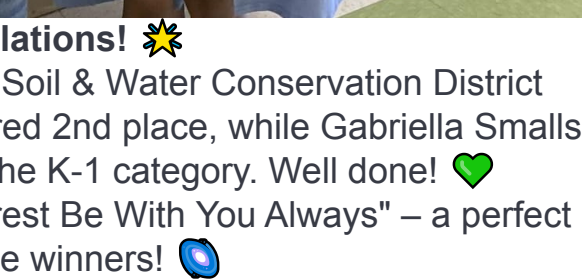
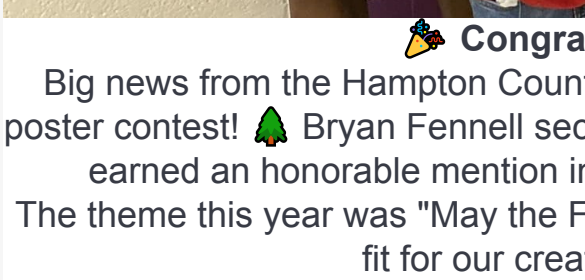

Yemassee Autism Awareness Program

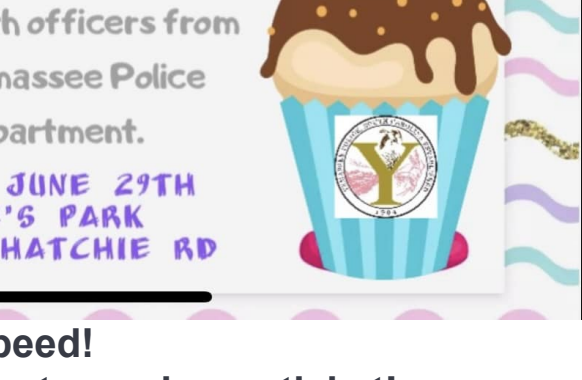

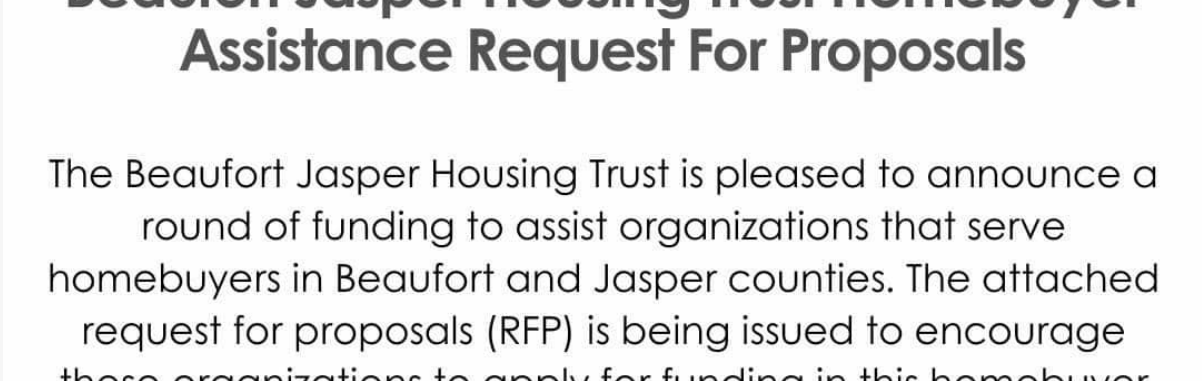
