- > Priority Investment

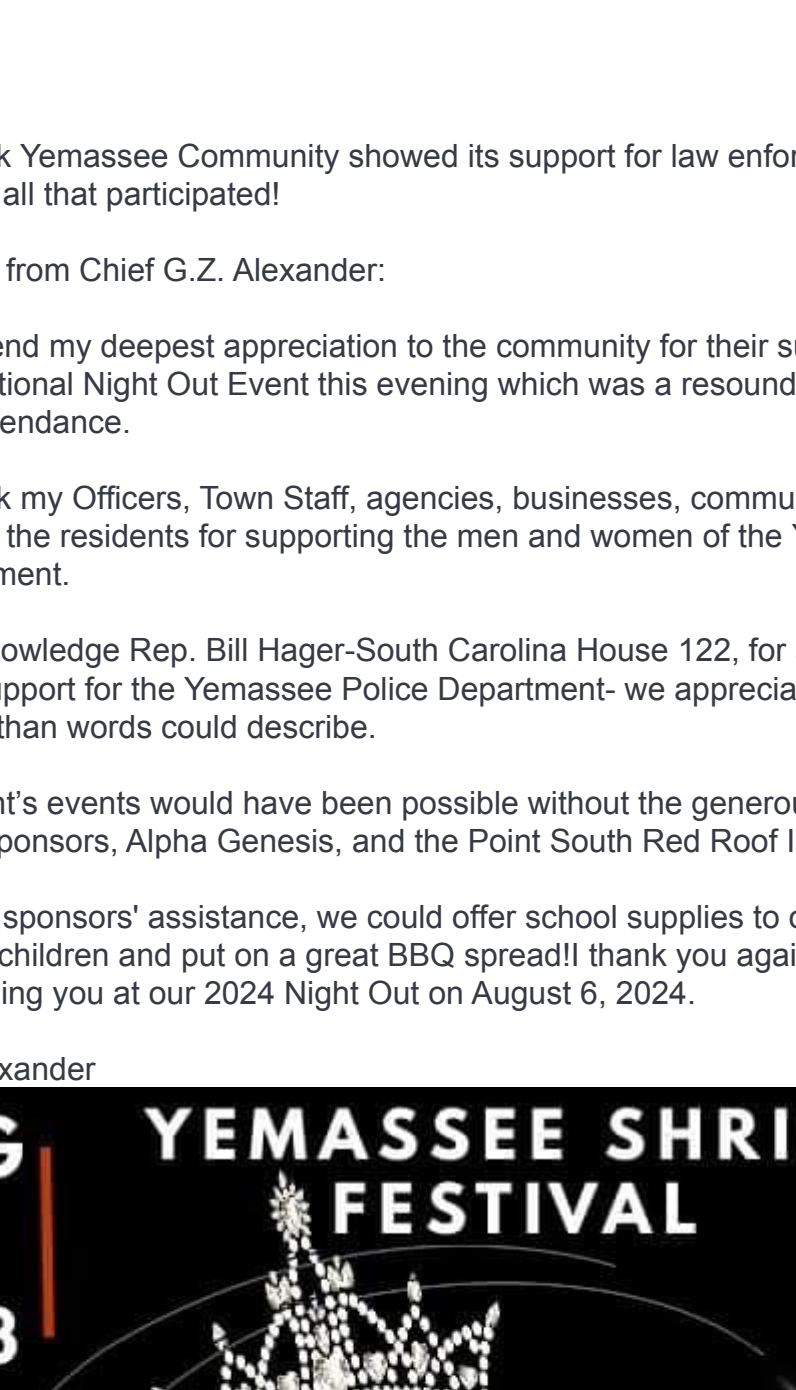
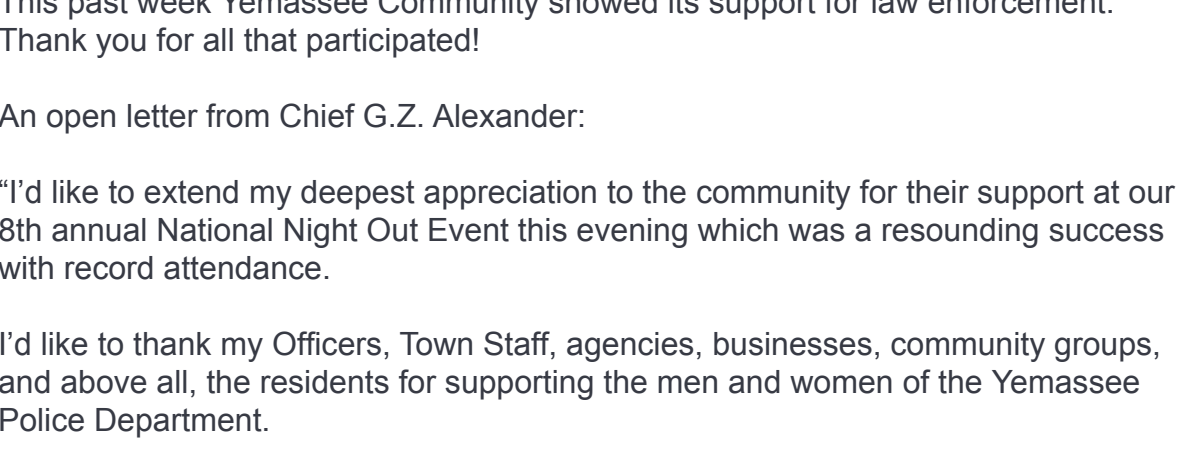
