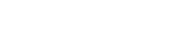
The Town of Yemassee proudly acknowledges Mr. Tom Risse's exceptional




