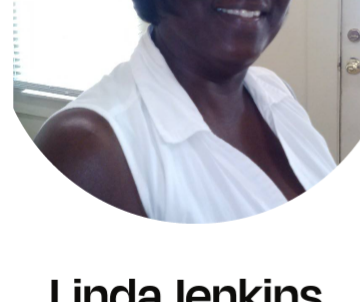


### Election Commission is critical to democracy

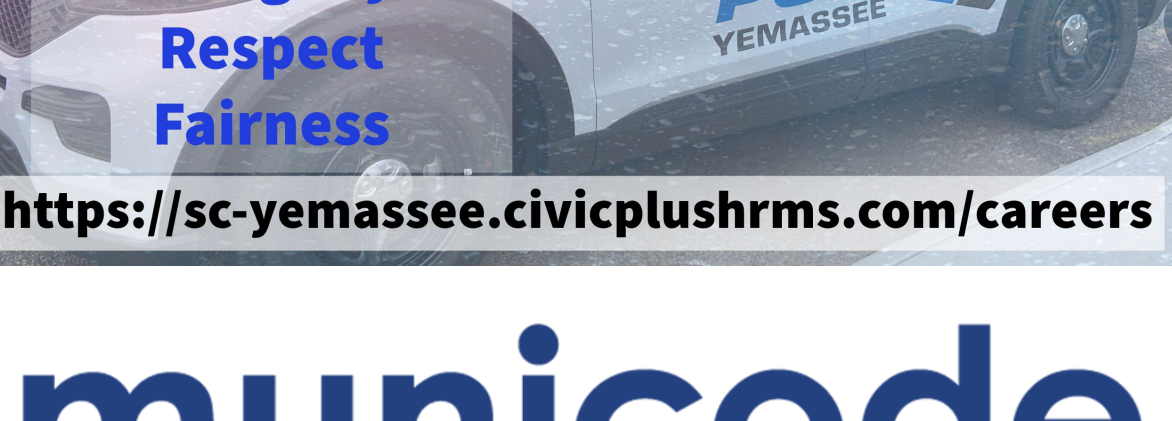
