

527 Acres of Cotton Hall Preserved



The recent purchase of the 527-acre property, Cotton Hall, in the Town of Yemassee by Beaufort County and Open Space Institute (OSI) has many benefits for our community.

First and foremost, this acquisition will contribute to expanding a conserved land network that connects the ACE Basin and Port Royal Sound watersheds. Such a network is vital for preserving natural habitats and fostering a healthier environment for wildlife and residents.

A noteworthy advantage of this purchase is establishing the first passive park in the ACE Basin. This park will offer a tranquil and serene space for residents and visitors to enjoy nature without interfering with its delicate balance.

Working together with Council Member Dawson and the County staff, the Town of Yemassee will be able to identify, create, and offer passive recreation opportunities, enriching the community's overall well-being.

Cotton Hall's diverse ecological features, including biologically rich bottomland hardwoods, expansive flooded impoundments, and mature upland forests, present a unique opportunity to experience and appreciate nature's wonders up close. The property's historical homesite adds cultural significance to the area, providing a deeper connection to the region's heritage.

A tree-canopied section of US Highway 17 stretching for 2.5 miles, accompanied by a large saltwater pond and open fields, opens up a wide range of passive recreational activities. Residents can partake in activities such as fishing and hiking, encouraging a more active and healthier lifestyle while enjoying the beautiful natural surroundings.
