MEDICARE ADVANTAGE OPEN ENROLLMENT JANUARY 1ST-MARCH 31ST

Parts of Medicare

Original Medicare
Part A hospital insurance covers inpatient hospital care, skilled nursing facility, hospice, lab tests, surgery, home health care.
Part B insurance covers doctors visits, preventive services, ambulance and durable medical equipment.

Part D
Part D (Medicare drug coverage) helps cover cost of prescription drugs may lower your costs and protect against higher costs.

Medicare Advantage Plan (Part C)
Part C is a way to get your Medicare Part A and B through private insurance companies. These plans may also include Part D, dental, hearing and vision.

What can I do?
If you're enrolled in a Medicare Advantage Plan (with or without drug coverage), you can switch to another Medicare Advantage Plan (with or without drug coverage).
You can drop your Medicare Advantage Plan and return to Original Medicare. You'll also be able to join a Medicare Prescription Drug Plan.
What can't I do?
Switch from Original Medicare to a Medicare Advantage Plan.
Join a Medicare Prescription Drug Plan if you're in Original Medicare.
Switch from one Medicare Prescription Drug Plan to another if you're in Original Medicare.
***Coverage will begin the 1st day of the following month.**

A COMMUNITY BASED EDUCATION AND SUPPORT GROUP WITH CLEMSON COOPERATIVE EXTENSION SERVICE

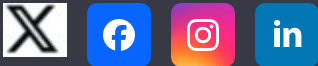
