PRESENT: Mayor Cook, Council Member Moore, O'Banner, Jinks, and Clerk Misty Reardon.

ABSENT: Council Member Anderson.

INVOCATION: Invocation was given by Mayor Cook.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: Given by Council Member O'Banner.

ACTION ON MINTUES FROM JULY 12TH, JULY 23RD& AUGUST 9TH, 2016: Motion to amend minutes for a later time by Council Member O'Banner second by Council Member Moore. All were in favor.

<u>DETERMINATION OF QUORUM</u>: Mayor Cook and Entire Town Government were present except Council Member Anderson was absent.

<u>DETERMINATION OF NOTICE OF PRESS</u>: Press has been notified by fax.

MAINTENANCE OF PROPERTIES: Council Member Jinks stated that the community center roof is leaking and needs to be repaired as soon as possible and that he also spoke with Mrs. Rosa from Hampton County as to where Yemassee stood for getting a new center in place which she informed him that it could take a good length in time before that would be able to take effect.
